## Selleck unveils traveling memorial exhibits in D.C.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Emmy-award winner Tom Selleck visited the National Mall in Washington, D.C., on Thursday to launch new exhibits for a traveling museum honoring Vietnam veterans.

The 64-year-old actor joined members of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund as they unveiled exhibits for The Wall That Heals, a 45-foot aluminum trailer that travels across

the country to people who may not have the opportunity to visit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington.

During the ceremony, Selleck thanked veterans and stressed the importance of remembering the Vietnam War.

"That war taught the American people a lesson that we can and we must honor our warriors, no matter what our feelings about the war," Selleck said.
